- Signatures of owner, riders, handlers, coach, trainer and consent for junior exhibitor if appropriate.
- Copy of each horse's registration papers with pedigree.
- Copies of your current AHA Competition cards. If you are not a current member of AHA, there is a \$35.00 Single Event Membership fee per person.
- A \$5.00 fee per horse entered for Resolution 9-90. This fee is mandatory and must be included.
- A check made payable to RCAHA for all fees included on the entry form. There will be a \$40.00 charge per check for any returned checks.

TBA List

RCAHA has allotted space for TBA classes. TBA classes may be any class on the AHA class list or that is recognized by AHA with the exception of trail, dressage, cutting, reined cow, or hunter/jumper. These classes may be placed throughout the schedule, but there are only a limited number available.

TBA Fee is \$50/class for regular classes and \$75/class for Championship classes plus the class entry fee.

TBA's are given on a first come first served basis only and must be reserved by close of entries with the show secretary.

There are a limited number of box stalls available and they will be assigned on a "First Come" basis. The stall fee is \$150.00. The stalls will be available Sept 22, 2023 and must be vacated by 9:30 PM on Sept 25, 2023. Stalls have top doors and are of premium wood & wire mesh construction with full swinging doors and dirt floor. Shavings will be available on grounds for purchase.

STALL DECORATIONS

Stall decorations shall be made of non-flammable or treated material and maintained in flame retardant condition.

SHOWING FROM TRAILERS

Exhibitors MAY show from their trailers. The trailer-in/grounds fee is **\$35.00 PER HORSE PER DAY**. Every horse entered in these shows MUST pay either a stall fee or trailer-in/grounds fee

TRAILER PARKING AREAS

As soon as horses are unloaded, vehicles must be moved to designated parking areas.

CLASS CALLS

Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical devices, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system to carry class calls; however, no protest will be upheld, nor will any class be changed on the basis of PA malfunction alone.

REFUNDS

Horses may be scratched from the show at the owner's option. Refunds of entry fees will be considered for any horse suffering from illness or injury upon the presentation of a veterinarian's certificate accompanied with a letter explaining the circumstances to the Show Secretary PRIOR to the start of said show. Requests for any refunds due to the illness or injury of the exhibitor, and accompanied with a letter from the doctor, will be considered and will be subject to Management's decision if they are received PRIOR to the start of said show. AMATEUR & JR HIGH POINTS ADULT AMATEURS AND JR RIDER AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED. YOU MUST SIGN UP TO HAVE YOUR POINTS COUNTED. **USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

USEF SAFE SPORT STATEMENT - All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies

USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION FOR EC AMATEUR MEMBERS - EC amateur members, competing in amateur classes, must complete and sign a USEF membership application verifying they meet USEF amateur requirements. There is no charge.

NEW AMATEUR/OWNER RULE - Combined ownership is permitted in Owner's or Amateur Owner's classes. PLEASE SEE THE usef rule book rule — AR110.4.e

USEF MEMBERSHIP - Affidavits are no longer accepted for payment of non-member fees. Exhibitors must have a Competing Membership, either Life, Senior Active or Junior Active Member or pay a Show Pass Fee. See next paragraph.

USEF NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION - If membership documentation is not submitted to the competition and the competition cannot verify such information, the exhibitor will be required to complete a Show Pass form and pay a non-refundable Show Pass fee of \$45.00. (GR1309.2.b) Show passes must be purchased online at USEF.org. A Show Pass is only valid for one competition and non-member participants (riders, drivers, handlers, vaulters, longeurs, owners, lessees, and agents) are limited to obtaining no more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year.

AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS – Copies of ALL trainer's, driver's, rider's and Breeding/Halter handler's and at least ONE Owner's current AHA COMPETITION Membership Cards MUST be included with the horse show entry form at the time of entry. Any owner, trainer, driver, rider, breeding/halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horses at the show must be a current competition member of A.H.A. at the time of entry and at the time of showing. An AHA Single Event Membership Fee of \$35.00 must be paid ONE TIME ONLY if not a current competition member of AHA or you do not have a current competition card. Membership Affidavits are no longer available.

AMATEUR OWNER FAMILY DEFINITION - An Amateur Owner Class is one in which every contestant is an Amateur and the rider, driver, or handler is the Owner or an Amateur Member of the owner's family. "Family" includes husband, wife, parent, step-parent, child, brother, stepchild, sister, half-brother, half-sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, grandmother, grandfather, and in-laws of the same relation as stated.

ARENA DIMENSIONS & FOOTING – Large outdoor arena (A) 150 x 300'; All arenas have a mixture of sand and dirt for footing.

CALIFORNIA DRUG FEE – A \$14.00 fee per horse (mandatory) will be collected for State of California Drug Testing program.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CRUELTY AND ABUSE - AHA ARTICLE 304.6 WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AT ALL AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITIONS.

DISCIPLINE - Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider or driver will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse owner, lessee, trainer, groom or rider from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

VETERINARIAN

The on-call Veterinarian is Equine Health Management (951) 813-6180. (Posted in Show Office)

GATE RULE - Due to a full schedule of classes the TWO-MINUTE limit after last call for a class will be strictly enforced. Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. The gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than 2 minutes at the completion of final horse in the continuous string of horses. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE SURE THAT HIS/HER HORSE IS AT THE GATE ON TIME. CLASS CALLS MUST BE CONSIDERED A COURTESY ONLY. No protests will be upheld on the basis of a public address system malfunction. "Open" cards may be run for hunter/jumper and Sport Horse In Hand classes to assist exhibitors who might have a conflict with classes in another arena. Check with show manager or in the show office for details.

ARABIAN HALF/ANGLO ARABIAN ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE —

1. Purebred Arabian Horses shown in the Arabian Division must have been issued a certificate of registration from either the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc., the Arabian Horse Association as a Purebred Arabian and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry as a Purebred Arabian (or in the case of a foreign entry, which has not been issued said certificate of registration, have been issued a Competition Visa by the Arabian Horse Association).
2. Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Horses shown in the Arabian division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the International Arabian Horse Association or the Arabian Horse Association or the Canadian Partbred Arabian Registry as a Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian.
3. Purebred Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian horses, if under one year of age, must be eligible for registry, and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name.

HALF ARABIAN/ANGLO ARABIAN COLTS/STALLIONS – Half Arabian and Anglo-Arabian stallions registered with AHA, or which have been issued an AHA CPAR (Canadian Part-bred Arabian Register) Permit, are permitted to compete in the AHA PERFORMANCE CLASSES for HA/AA and Anglo-Arabian horses. Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian colts & stallions, two years & older, may compete in Sport Horse In Hand Classes.

ANDALUSIAN REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS — Purebred and Half-Andalusian horses to be shown in a local or regional competition must be registered with or application for registration made to IALHA. Weanlings and yearlings are eligible if both parents are either registered or application has been made to register them with IALHA. In order to be qualified to enter the ring in a National Championship class, the horse must be registered with the IALHA and a copy of the registration papers on file with the Competition Secretary. Weanlings and yearlings may enter a National Championship Class without a copy of the registration papers on file with the Competition Secretary if and only if the Competition Secretary has received a letter from the IALHA Registrar or Half-Andalusian Registration Secretary identifying the weanling or yearling and certifying that each and every requirement for registration of such weanling or yearling has been met and the registration certificate will be issued. Lineage must be traceable back to the Spanish or Portuguese Stud Books. Copies of registration papers must be mailed with entries or presented at each competition.

HEADGEAR – All juniors riding in Hunter Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitting protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling & exercise areas, the show ring, and while jumping anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEA) in any division or class without penalty from the judge.

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES - All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Rancho California Arabian Horse Association and Green Acres Ranch Inc. not be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. Acres Ranch Inc. against any and all loss damages and liability thus occasioned including, but not limited to, any and all legal costs including attorney fees which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.

JUDGES - If for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or perform his/her duties the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Prize List. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision, or, at any time, unless he first obtains permission from the Show Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

JSDF Membership Benefits: USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The JSDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable JSDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

USDF Statement on Animal Welfare

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of over 100 independent organizations throughout the United States with a membership of nearly 30,000 members, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a classical method of training horses, based upon the horse's natural responses, as carried out in a gradual, planned program during which the horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable, and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of artificial appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc., also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter; as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs, which teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.

Vesicular stomatitis (VS) Requirements and Mitigation Measures

This show will be inacting the following requirements per USEF/CDFA

- Timed Official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) for horses from VS Affected State(s): Must be accompanied by an official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) which includes a VS statement and issued within 5 days of entry to competition grounds by a licensed veterinarian who has examined the horse. Only state issued/ approved official CVI document shall be accepted.

The certificate must include the following information:

VS statement :“I have examined the animal(s) represented on this certificate of veterinary inspection and have found no clinical signs of vesicular stomatitis and they have not originated from a premises under quarantine for vesicular stomatitis.”

- There will be an onsite designated individual examination of all horses from VS Affected States for vesicular lesions at time of entry to venue. No horse will be permitted entry to stabling, schooling, or competition area without veterinary examination.
- The show will have a Designated individual –Designated Individual: An individual designated by the competition veterinarian OR an individual designated by the competition manager who has proof of completion of the USEF online VS Educational module (to be posted to USEF website by July 1, 2023).
- The show will reject of any horse or load of horses with suspect lesions.
- Horses from VS affected counties will be stabled (if stabling is required) in a separate designated stabling area.
- The show will be monitoring horses from VS Affected States for the duration of the event.
- Stall temperature logs required to be completed with twice daily temperature recordings. An Individual designated by competition management to directly observe horses originating from VS affected states for vesicular lesions daily.
- The show will immediately notify the State Veterinarian’s office and USEF Equine Health and Biosecurity Veterinarian of any suspect lesions.
- The show will Vector Control Measures on the premises including but not limited to encouraging the use of individual vector control of fly sprays, wipes, or protective covering and premises control measures to eliminate fly breeding areas.
